

## **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR A TAX-EXEMPT NONSTOCK CORPORATON**

**FIRST:** The undersigned, David J. Novack, whose address is in c/o Budd Lerner, PC, 150 J.F. K. Parkway, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Short Hills, New Jersey 07078, being at least eighteen years of age, does hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Maryland.

**SECOND:** The name of the corporation is Zone 8 of the Porsche Club of America, Inc.

**THIRD:** The purpose for which the corporation is formed is to promote increased knowledge and interest in the Porsche automobile and its history and to provide educational activities concerning the Porsche automobile for its members and others who share a similar interest in the Porsche automobile.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

**FOURTH:** The street address of the principal office of the corporation in Maryland is Porsche Club of America, Inc., 9689 Gerwig Lane, Unit 4 c/d, Columbia, MD 21046

**FIFTH:** The name of the resident agent of the corporation in Maryland is Vu Nguyen, whose address is 9689 Gerwig Lane, Unit 4 c/d, Columbia, MD 21046.

**SIXTH:** The corporation has no authority to issue capital stock.

**SEVENTH:** The number of directors of the corporation shall be 13 which number may be increased or decreased pursuant to the bylaws of the corporation. The names of the directors who shall act until their successors are duly chosen and qualified are set forth on Exhibit A, which is annexed hereto and made a part hereof.

**EIGHTH:** No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code which applies to a Civic League or Section 501 (c)(7) which applies to a social club or the corresponding sections of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or two such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
