PCNA needs a 951 for Training!

PCNA is looking to buy a 951 as a training vehicle. To be eligible as a training vehicle, the following parameters must be met:

A Certificate of Authenticity is helpful, but not required

Engine and transmission must be original specification

--Modifications or upgrades must be Porsche approved

--No aftermarket FI, carburetors, ignition or turbo systems. Must be period correct.

Wheels, brakes, suspension components

--OEM in appearance, no aftermarket suspension components

Interior

--OEM components, no race seats, aftermarket speakers (OEM head unit must be installable)

--OEM airbags must be installed where applicable

--Interior must be restorable to OEM condition

Body Condition

--No detectable previous collision damage, door, fender or lid fit issues.

--No aftermarket spoilers, wings, body kits, body must be period correct.

--OEM paint color and restorable paint condition (no color changes)

--No existing rust perforation
