- Lori opened the meeting with "News from National"
- Membership is growing
- PCA's Red Book is online
 - Regions should take advantage of documenting their passwords in the PCA Red Book
- Club racing is still looking for a west coast sponsor
- There is interest in expanding the West Coast Series and there is an opportunity for a region to pull their resources with another region to hold a West Coast Series
 - If you have an interest, contact Van Svenson, 347-453-4255
 - Costs depend on the size of the race
 - Track expenses can range \$50 \$75K depending on venue
 - Event can be profitable
 - PCA is live streaming at a cost of ~\$9K

- One region rented Laguna Seca for \$37K and lost money on the event
- 70th Anniversary You Tube video by the decade is available
- Lori asked the regions to share what they were doing for the 70th anniversary:
 - Drive and a cars & coffee
 - Autofest largest car show in Nevada
 - New Member BBQ
 - Member picnic
 - Combining 2nd anniversary with a lunch, giveaways and access to simulators
 - Drive to Vasquez Rocks
- Board Meeting Minutes should be referred to "Notes" and not Meeting Minutes since Minutes can be subpoenaed
- If presidents receive a solicitation from "Roadstar" they should ignore
- Presidents are welcome to post their events to the PCA calendar
- Archiving waivers
 - Regions are typically holding onto hard copies of waivers
 - A couple of regions are scanning into drop box
 - If regions are scanning into drop box, be sure it is accessible by others
- Lake Placid will be the next Parade in 2026 and Boise, Idaho in 2027
- Next Treffen will be in South Carolina
- UnSTOCK is scheduled for November 16, 2025 in Santa Clarita
 - The region will be contacted closer to the event and will typically be asked for volunteers

 - Meeting doesn't have to be in January
 - Lori would like to have it on the agenda next month to discuss venue and have it somewhat set up for the incoming Zone 8 Rep
