Lori DeCristo called meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

- Lori opened the meeting with "News from National"
 - Parade is right around the corner
 - Treffen at Sea has ~900 PCA members registered
 - Temptations will be on board the ship for entertainment
 - Treffen Jackson Hole, WY sold out in 4 minutes with a registration fee of \$1,000 per person
 - Club racing is still being lived streamed
 - Treffen Europe will be in Stuttgart at \$8,000 per person (does not include airfare)
 - Homestead Treffen was a success
 - PCA will be holding its National Board Meeting on July 28th
- Club Anniversaries LAR will be combining their 65th Anniversary with PCA's 70th Anniversary on September 13th
- Guest Dave Douglas provided an overview of a driving tour app, "Ride with GPS"
 - Ride with GPS is a powerful app, similar to building a library of routes for members

- \$250 annual fee
- Download route to your device this allows members who are in the tour group to never lose the map
- A feature of the app is that it can communicate additional details such as photo opp ahead, downshifting necessary, etc.
- Dave is willing to digitize a regional route
- Lori would like to have a Zone 8 library of routes and encourages each region to submit their routes for digitizing purposes
- Post Event and Observer's, and if necessary, Incident Reports are reports required to be submitted to National after a moving vehicle event
 - o Reports are required for legal and insurance purposes
- "Non-seasoned" members
 - There was a discussion regarding attracting younger members to PCA
 - It was suggested to increase social activities
 - Have face-to-face conversations, text younger people, etc.
 - Attracting younger members is an on-going challenge
- Upcoming Concours schedule
 - San Gabriel Valley, Covina City Hall, September 14th
 - San Diego Region Liberty Station, September 21st
 - Santa Barbara Region Camarillo House, October 12th
 - Arizona Region Flight 47, November 1st
- Discussion on usage of subsidy funds
 - o Most regions utilize subsidy funds to help offset costs of events being subsidized
 - No regions have directive in their bylaws on how the subsidy funds are to be used
- Lori will provide Gary Lea with the names of Parade attendees from his region
 - o Parade Zone parties will be combined with the Sunday night event
- National does not currently have a Registrar
- LA Region has rented an entire theater this Saturday for Brad Pitt's F1 Movie
 - o Fee is \$30 per ticket
- There is no Zone 8 President's Meeting in July
